

### INITIAL DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

Client Provides or Commissions Artwork Artwork Admin: Free - £50 per Hour



Balineum has a range of existing artwork that can be used and modified by clients across our many tile collections: Hanley Tube Line, Louis Barthelemy Egyptomania, Lioness & Palms, JP Demeyer Fearless Eyes, Fee Greening Curious Tiles, Wayne Pate, and Series S Italian Decorative tiles. If you choose from within our colour palettes, there is no cost for your custom colourway. Very simple modifications to our existing designs may not incur additional charges — we will confirm if this is the case with your brief.

We do not design or develop custom tile artwork for clients but we can take your references and put them on a tile. We can suggest artists or other pattern sources for inspiration but we don't currently have the graphic design skills in-house to create bespoke tile designs to a client brief. We require artwork as a high resolution file (JPEG, PDF, PNG, etc) or an antique reference that is able to be copied.

We reserve the right to charge clients for our team's time if they require assistance formatting artwork or developing new designs, although it is rare that this is required.

### NEW DESIGN: NEW SCREEN OR MURAL ART WORK

New Silk Screen: £180 per Tile Design Mural 'Artworking' Fee: £60 per SQM





All individual tile designs require a silk screen that will be used to screen print a vegetable dye outline of the pattern on to each tile. This ensures consistent alignment across a wall of tiles. The decorating team use the dye outline as a guide when hand painting or tube lining each tile, which gives them the subtle and pleasing variation you would expect from a handmade product.

For mural designs, a tile grid will be transposed over the artwork. We then print the mural to size with a specialist printer. Each tile is then hand traced to ensure alignment over a large area. Mural artworking is charged per SQM.

#### NEW GLAZE COLOURS

Working with Existing Balineum Glazes: Free New Simple Glazes: £300 per RAL / Pantone match Complex / Historical Glazes: £800 per match



Across all Balineum tile collections we have existing glazes for clients to choose from. There are more than 35 glazes in Hanley as well as a range of underglaze colours; 8 glazes in Terra Firma bricks; 10 in Mottled tiles; 33 in Series S. We find most clients can work within these palettes.

Clients who require lighter or darker modifications from an existing glaze, or custom colour (to match RAL or Pantone) will need to pay for new glaze development. Allow 6-12 weeks for developing a new custom glaze.

Clients wanting particularly complicated glazes — highly reactive glazes, specialist applications like mottling or an aged effect, or historical tile matches — should expect glaze development charges to start from £800 per glaze and allow 12-18 weeks plus.

#### NEW SHAPES: TILE CUTTERS OR SLIP CAST MOULDS

Tile Cutter: £300 per Shape 4 - 6 Weeks to Make New Cutter

Slip Cast Mould: £2,500 - £10,000 8 - 12 Weeks for Mould Development



If you require a new shape that we do not already make there will likely be a cutter or mould making charge.

For extruded plain tiles we can make cutters – much like biscuit cutters — which cost £300 per cutter. These tiles are limited to 152 mm wide and must be flat. Please note all our hand cut tiles will have  $\pm 2\%$  variaton.

Slip casting is a far more elaborate and expensive process. Shapes that are not flat or are wider than 152mm must be slip cast. Size variation on slip cast pieces is  $\pm 1\%$ . Developing a new slip cast piece requires design time, a 3D print, a master mould and then working moulds. Costs start at £2500. It will take a minimum of 8 weeks to develop a mould, in addition to production time.

### TILE SAMPLES

Plain: £5 - £60+ per Tile Tube Line / Hand Painted £15 - £55+ per Tile 4 - 12 Weeks



Many clients require physical tile samples for sign off prior to final production. Samples can be used to check colours and finishes. Please note: All of our tiles can and will vary across different firings so any tile samples are to be used as good guide only.

Lead time: Please allow 4-6 weeks for pre-production samples to be made, after client artwork has been provided and glazes have been selected. More complicated projects may require longer for sampling.

The final price of your tile will depend on the design complexity (ie the time it takes to make). Our standard tile collections are a good indication of final tile costs.

Most client orders (less than 15 SQM) can be produced within 8-12 weeks. Our production capacity and lead times vary throughout the year and your sales contact can confirm lead times once the final design and order size is known.

### PRODUCTION ORDER: MURAL DESIGN

Plain:£25 per Tile

Tube Line / Hand Painted: £40 / £55 per Tile

Mural projects will take longer than single repeat tiles. The preparation and creation process is more complex as is the firing process. Although most tiles will be unique, colours and alignment will still need to match across the installation. A mural commission will not take less than 10 weeks once the final design has been agreed.

Decorated tiles are the most time consuming, and therefore, expensive tile to produce in a mural. Plain mural tiles are more affordable by comparison. They must still be hand painted in a single colour to ensure they match back to the decorated tiles in the mural. As they cannot be produced on a dip line ( a conveyor belt we use to apply glaze to plain tiles), they are more expensive than our standard solid colour tiles.

### OTHER CHARGES

Tile Cutting: £50 per Hour or per Cut Low Volume Setup Fee: Project Dependant



The most common and typical charges are listed in the preceding sections.

Low volumes:

If you only require one or two tiles, there may be an order setup fee. We only give trade discounts on orders with 20 tiles or more. Every production order has setup time regardless of whether we make 1 tile or 100 tiles.

There is a cutting charge if we trim a small number of tiles to size or hand cut a shape. This is charged at £50 per hour or per cut depending on the project. For larger volumes, a cutter or mould is required.

# UK TILES VS ITALIAN TILES

Our tiles are made by hand in the UK and Italy. The key difference between the ranges is the final appearance or style and whether tiles are intended for the floor. There is little difference in the price or lead times. We will work with a client to suggest which maker is best for their project and it is possible to create samples with both makers.
