

STEP 1 - INITIAL BRIEF WITH WAYNE

Wayne will have an initial virtual consultation with the client to review the details of the project, its style, any references to consider, and the scale of the site. This can be via phone, email, or video conference. This information will help us determine how long Wayne should allow for creating artwork in Step 2.

STEP 2 - WAYNE ARTWORKING

£1000.00 MINIMUM 1 DAY MINIMUM

The scale and time of artworking will be determined by the scale of the project. There is a minimum charge of £1000.00 for this step. We bill Wayne's time by the day. Before beginning this step, we will estimate how many days this will take and send you an invoice for this amount. This fee needs to be paid in advance.

We allow for some client iterations within this estimate, but if the project takes longer or if the client requests a lot of alterations, taking more of Wayne's time, an additional invoice will be issued. We will communicate this, if it happens.

STEP 3 - COSTING MURAL

1-2 WEEKS

After we receive the artwork from Wayne, we can cost out the mural. The final price is determined by its size and complexity. We will send you an estimate for the mural plus shipping to its final location. A 50% deposit is required to confirm your order and start work. The balance will be due prior to delivery.

STEP 4 - MURAL PRODUCTION

£2500.00 MINIMUM 8-20 WEEKS

Final mural pricing is entirely determined by its size and complexity. The more time it takes to make, the more it will cost.

The most affordable custom mural option is to hand-paint flat tiles with Wayne's artwork. It is still expensive, but it is more affordable than 3D relief murals. A hand-painted flat tile mural would be ideal as a tabletop or as a tiled painting used as a backsplash or feature wall in a kitchen, garden or fireplace surround.

We have also been creating textural 3D relief murals. We have made three of these murals over the last 18 months to test scale, format, and decorative elements.

As a guide, this is what you can expect and should budget for textural murals:

Plain terracotta with two glaze colours Trade price (per piece): £2000 per piece All of the above murals were made using raised elements. This is a more expensive method of production. All use clay pieces in large formats. The largest clay pieces we work with are around 50cm. Pieces larger than this are likely to break during production or handling.

INSTALLATION

Neither Balineum nor Wayne Pate will be responsible for on-site mural installation. The above costs and charges are for the cost of the ceramic mural only.

We are happy to answer questions about mural installation and advise where we can, but we expect the final installation will be directed by the client, be it incorporated into a wall or hung with or without a frame. As examples, Atelier Vime designed and built a wooden frame with contemporary brass hanging rods for their Provence installation and Garce Dimofski hung their mural without any frame, using only simple brackets
